OTDS campuses are registered Career Colleges under the Ontario Career College's Act 2005.

All nine locations offer one-on-one driving training. This kind of private driving instruction offers students maximum hands-on driving time and minimal distractions.

The fleet, comprising of manual and automated transmission tractors and dump trucks also include both school and coach buses, vans along with 53' box trailers and float trailers. Heavy equipment and aerial lift vehicles are available at our London Head Office campus.

All of OTDS locations have solid relationships with Carriers, providing pre-hire driver assessments, skillset upgrades, and remedial training.

Ontario Truck Driving School is a founding member of the Truck Training Schools Association of Ontario (1993) and more recently the Continental Transport Safety Association (2020). OTDS schools have been certified by the TTSAO and CTSA. These associations are recognized provincially and nationally as trucking school certification entities.
